At the end of April, our financial situation looked more positive. We had \$60,105 in income for the month. The budget presumed income year to date at that point of \$195,333 and we had received \$220,230! Admittedly, even if we're on budget we still are looking at an annual deficit of \$91,000. April had Easter Sunday in it. But even so, it appears many of the members are trying to respond to the church's financial plight. It's difficult for the Ministry of Finance really to know for sure we're coming out of the woods because so much of the income is not 'pledged.' By the end of May we had fallen behind a bit more, so clearly we still need help. We do know that almost \$9,000 has been committed to the deficit challenge started at the Annual Meeting. Thanks to everyone who is helping!

YPS GOES NUTS FOR THE HUNGRY

YPS is asking everyone to bring one or more jars of PEANUT BUTTER to church this Sunday for their drive to get 100 jars to take to the Food Pantry for the hungry. Also, for every grocery item the congregation donates for the food pantry before the end of August, MOM will donate an additional \$1 worth of groceries to the cause, up to \$500.
